**WHEREAS**, an application has been filed for a place-to-place transfer (Expansion of Premises) of Plenary Retail Consumption License with Broad C Package Privilege # 2006-32-006-005, LAXMEE, LLC, a Limited Liability Co., dba Dittrick's Wines and Liquors, for purposes of expanding the premises under license wherein the sale, service, and storage of alcoholic beverages are authorized;

**WHEREAS**, the submitted application form is complete in all respects, the transfer fees have been paid, and the license has been properly renewed for the current license term;

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-095**

**Resolution Urging the Swift Passage of S-330 which restores Energy Tax Receipts**

**WHEREAS**, taxes on gas and electric utilities were originally collected by the host municipalities to be used for local purposes and to compensate the public for the use of their rights of way; and

**WHEREAS**, when the State made itself the collection agent for these taxes, it promised to dedicate the proceeds to municipal property tax relief; since, just as municipalities collect property taxes for the benefit of school districts, counties, and other entities, the State is supposed to collect Energy Taxes for the benefit of municipal governments; and

**WHEREAS**, for years, though, State budget makers have diverted funding from Energy Taxes to fund State programs; and instead of being spent on local programs and services and used to offset property taxes, the money has been spent as successive Legislatures and Administrations have seen fit; and

**WHEREAS**, the diversion of dedicated energy tax receipts to the State's General Fund further jeopardizes this critical property tax relief funding in future years; and

**WHEREAS**, by reducing Consolidated Municipal Property Tax Relief Act (CMPTRA), which is also comprised of revenues that should be returned to municipalities, State Budget makers have been able to continue collecting Energy Taxes, while keeping additional revenue that should have been returned to provide property tax relief; and

**WHEREAS**, the cumulative impact of years of underfunding has left many municipalities with serious needs and burdensome property taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, local elected officials are in the best position to decide the best use of these resources, which were always intended to fund local programs and services; and

**WHEREAS**, Senator Singleton and Senate President Scutari have introduced legislation (S-330) that will restore, over a five-year period, Energy Tax Receipts to municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, Assembly members Benson, Moriarty and Jaffer have introduced a companion legislation (A-3804); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the governing body of the Borough of Garwood in the County of Union urges the Legislature to swiftly pass this legislation and Governor Murphy to sign the legislation prior to passage of the FY2023 State budget; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this Resolution is forwarded to Assembly Members Munoz and Matsikoudis, Senator Bramnick, Senate President Scutari, Assembly Speaker Coughlin, Governor Murphy, and the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-096**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Garwood, Department of the Police is in need of a Civilian Police Dispatcher as defined in Chapter 34. Police Department, Article VI, Section 37-40 of the Code of the Borough of Garwood; and

**WHEREAS**, the Civilian Police Dispatcher shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and Council under the direction of James H. Wright, Chief of Police in the Department of the Police.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Borough of Garwood hereby hires Diana Sinchi-Beltran as Civilian Police Dispatcher.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Borough of Garwood that Diana Sinchi-Beltran, shall be compensated \$34,000 per year as Civilian Police Dispatcher, Probationary Class, effective June 13, 2022; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that her employment is subject to the terms and conditions of employment in the Borough of Garwood, including one-year probation commencing July 5, 2022.

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-097**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND MUNICIPAL CLERK OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF UNION TO MODIFY THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT DATED JUNE 2014, AS AMENDED JULY 2017.**

**WHEREAS**, certain Federal funds are potentially available to the County of Union under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Block Grant Act of 1974, as amended, commonly known as the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, certain Federal funds are potentially available to the County of Union under Title II of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, commonly known as the HOME Investment Partnership program; and

**WHEREAS**, substantial Federal funds provided through subtitle B of Title IV of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act commonly known as the Emergency Solutions Grants program (ESG) are allocated to prevent homelessness and to enable homeless individuals and families to move toward independent living; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend an existing Cooperative Agreement for the County of Union and its people to benefit from this program; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the Municipality of the Borough of Garwood and the County of Union in cooperation with each other to enter into a modification of the existing Cooperative Agreement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Governing Body of the Municipality of the Borough of Garwood that the agreement entitled **“COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF UNION AND CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES FOR CONDUCTING CERTAIN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES,”** dated June 2014, as amended July 2017 for the Purpose of Inserting a Description of Activities for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 of the Union County Community Development Block Grant program, the HOME Investment Partnership program, and the Emergency Shelter Grant program (ESG), a copy of which is attached hereto; be executed by the Mayor and Municipal Clerk in accordance with the provisions of law;  
**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-098**

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ronald Marczewski of the Church of St. Anne in Garwood is taking his well earned and deserved retirement after 48 years in ministry in the Roman Catholic Church. Monsignor Ron, as he is commonly referred to as, has faithfully served the Garwood community as Monsignor of the Church of St. Anne for the past six years with pride and dedication; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ron has been very supportive of the local Police and Fire Departments, including his service as Chaplain of the Garwood Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ron has delivered the invocations and benedictions at the annual Memorial Service held by the Garwood Fire Department in memory of their deceased members and members of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Garwood Fire Department as well as the annual Memorial Day Remembrance Service hosted by the Garwood Celebrations Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ron has participated in numerous other community events, including, but not limited to the Rededication of Police Officer Thomas P. Haughton Memorial Plaza and the Veterans Day Service at the Purple Heart Monument located at Georgiana Gurrieri Memorial Park; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ron is a 4th Degree Member of the Knights of Columbus and is the Chaplain for both the Garwood Knights of Columbus and the Union County 4th Degree Knights of Columbus; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ron was born in Bayonne, raised in Roselle Park, and ordained in 1974 and served as an Associate of St. Adalbert in Elizabeth, as Campus Ministry at Rutgers University and the New Jersey Institute of Technology, before taking a one year leave to study spirituality in Rome, England, and Ireland; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Ron continued his ministry as the Chaplain of Essex Catholic Boys High School, then served as Executive Director of the CYO Youth and Young Adults Ministry, then returned to St. Adalbert in Elizabeth for ten years as Pastor, then spent ten years as Pastor at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Bayonne, before arriving at the Church of St. Anne in Garwood on July 1, 2016;

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-099**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LIEN AGAINST THE PROPERTIES LISTED HEREIN FOR THE COST OF REMOVING FROM THE PROPERTIES BRUSH, WEEDS, DEAD AND DYING TREES, STUMPS, ROOTS, OBNOXIOUS GROWTHS, FILTH, GARBAGE, LITTER AND DEBRIS IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.14 AND THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD CODE SECTION 99-17**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.14 and Borough of Garwood Code Section 99-17 authorize municipalities by Ordinance to require the owners of the property to remove from their property or destroy brush, weeds, including ragweed, dead and dying trees, stumps, roots, obnoxious growth, filth, garbage trash and debris within five (5) days after notice to remove or destroy same; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.14 and Borough of Garwood Code Section 99-17 provide that if owners fail to remove brush, stumps, debris, etc. from the property after receiving such notice, the Borough may do the removal and charge the costs to the owner; and if not paid, the governing body may cause the cost to become a lien against the properties; and

**WHEREAS**, this lien may be enforced by the same officers and in the same manner as taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Borough of Garwood Code Section 99-17 a Notice and Order directed owners listed herein to remove from their property brush, weeds, debris, etc. within five (5) days of the date of Notice and Order; and

**WHEREAS**, the owners listed herein after receiving the after receiving the Notice and Order failed to remove brush, weeds, debris, etc. from their property; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result, the Department of Public Works (DPW) has removed the brush, stumps, weeds, etc. from the property; and

**WHEREAS**, the DPW has certified the cost of removal to the Council, and the Council has examined these costs and found them to be correct and reasonable.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Garwood, the Council hereby authorizes the Tax Collector of the Borough of Garwood to cause the cost as shown herein to be charged against said property as a lien:
