AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE VIIIA (OTHER OFFICES AND POSITIONS) IN CHAPTER 5 (ADMINISTRATION) OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD TO CREATE THE POSITION OF CLEAN COMMUNITIES COORDINATOR AND TO PRESCRIBE THE DUTIES AND SALARY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Garwood:

SECTION 1. Article VIIIA (Other Offices and Positions) in Chapter 5 (Administration) of the Code of the Borough of Garwood is hereby amended and supplemented by enacting § 5-51.19.20 through § 5-51.19.24 as follows:

§ 5-51.19.20. Clean Communities Coordinator.

The position of Clean Communities Coordinator of the Borough of Garwood is hereby created.

§ 5-51.19.21. Appointment of Clean Communities Coordinator.

The Clean Communities Coordinator shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council and shall serve at the pleasure of the Council. The Clean Communities Coordinator shall be exempt from the residency requirement of N.J.S.A. 40A:60-6.

§ 5-51.19.22. Duties of Clean Communities Coordinator.

- A. The duties of the Clean Communities Coordinator shall be as follows:
 - (1) Coordinate the enforcement of litter-related laws and ordinances.
 - (2) Publicize litter-related laws and ordinances.
 - (3) Coordinate the purchase of equipment or vehicles and materials and supplies used solely for the enforcement of litter-related laws and ordinances.
 - (4) Submit reports of activities to the Borough Council, through the Borough Administrator, when requested.
 - (5) Attend meetings of the Borough Council where specifically requested.

B. The Clean Communities Coordinator shall be directly responsible to the Mayor and Borough Council.

§ 5-51.19.23. Compensation of Clean Communities Coordinator.

The Mayor and Council shall fix the compensation or salary of the Clean Communities Coordinator by ordinance.

§ 5-51.19.24. Offices not incompatible with Clean Communities Coordinator.

Nothing contained in this Code shall be construed to prohibit the Clean Communities Coordinator from holding

any other office or position of the Borough of Garwood, unless incompatible.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any portion of this ordinance shall be determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
