AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE I (GENERAL PROVISIONS) IN CHAPTER 27 (FIRE DEPARTMENT) OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD TO REVISE THE CHAIN OF COMMAND AND THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Garwood:

SECTION 1. Section 27-2 (Organization and Election of Officers) and Section 27-14 (Fire Department personnel; membership) in Article I (General Provisions in Chapter 27 (Fire Department) of the Revised Ordinances of the Borough of Garwood is hereby amended to read as follows (Insertions indicated by underlining, deletions indicated by ~~striketroughs~~):

27-2. Organization and election of officers.

A. Officers; chain of command.

(1) The Fire Department shall consist of the following officers and men in order of chain of command:

First Deputy Chief	1
Second Deputy Chief	1
Third Deputy Chief	1
Assistant Chief	1
Captain	1
First Lieutenant	1
Second Lieutenant	1

27-14. Fire Department personnel; membership.

A. Any citizen of the United States, between the ages of 18 and 45 inclusive of his or her 46th birthday, who resides within three miles of the Borough limits shall be eligible to

probationary membership in the Department, providing he or she has passed a physical examination as required by the New Jersey Firemen's Association and a background check by the Garwood Police Department and has been approved by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Garwood. It shall be limited that no more than ~~28~~ 48% of the members of the Department reside outside the Borough of Garwood.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any portion of this ordinance shall be determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
