**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 21-8.6 (MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS) IN ARTICLE 21 (TRAFFIC AND PARKING) IN CHAPTER 21 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD TO REVISE CERTAIN REGULATIONS REGARDING MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Garwood:

**SECTION 1.** Section 21-8.6 (Municipal Parking Lots) in Article I (Traffic and Parking) in Chapter 21 (Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the Borough of Garwood is hereby amended to read as follows (Insertions indicated by underlining, deletions indicated by ~~strikethroughs~~):

- D. Parking prohibited temporarily for snow plowing, snow removal, maintenance, ~~and other emergencies and special events~~

    - a. Three (3) parking stalls reserved 24 hours a day/ 7 days per week for marked police

vehicle parking.

- b. Two (2) parking stalls reserved police vehicle parking 7AM to 5PM Monday through Friday.
- c. Two (2) parking stalls 15 minute parking 8AM to 5PM.
- d. One (1) parking stall reserved for Borough Staff parking 7AM to 5PM Monday through Friday.
