**ORDINANCE NO. 25-05**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD BY AMENDING CHAPTER 71, ENTITLED "BUSINESSES AND OCCUPATIONS," ARTICLE 1. HAWKERS, PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, CANVASSERS, DISTRIBUTORS OF ADVERTISING."**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Garwood (the "Borough") has previously adopted Chapter 71, of the Code of the Borough of Garwood, Article 1 establishing licenses and guidelines for hawkers, peddlers, solicitors, canvassers, and distributors of advertising; and

**WHEREAS**, § 71-6 of Chapter 71, Article 1 of the Borough Code, entitled "Expiration of License" sets forth the expiration date of licenses from the date of issuance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council seeks to amend the expirations of licenses and extend the time period for a valid license at the recommendation of the Chief of Police; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the governing body of the Borough of Garwood that Chapter 71 ("Businesses and Occupations"), Article 1 ("Hawkers, Peddlers, Solicitors, Canvassers, Distributors of Advertising"), subsection 71-6 is hereby amended as follows (additions underscored, deletions ~~struck through~~):

§ 71-6. Expiration of license.

Licenses issued under this article shall expire ~~six months~~ one (1) year from date of issuance.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that this Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
