AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GARWOOD BY AMENDING CHAPTER 21, SECTION 21-8.2, ENTITLED "FIFTEEN MINUTE PARKING."

WHEREAS, the Borough of Garwood (the "Borough") has previously adopted Chapter 21 of the Code of the Borough of Garwood which established and governs restrictions and regulations on parking and traffic in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is seeking to amend Section 21-8.2 "Fifteen-minute parking," and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined it appropriate to amend said Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Garwood that Chapter 21 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Garwood entitled, "Fifteen-minute parking," section 21-8.2, is hereby amended as follows (additions underscored, deletions struck-through):

No person shall park a motor vehicle upon any of the following streets and areas for more than 15 minutes duration between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Mondays through Saturdays:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Center Street</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>50 feet south of South Avenue</u>
<u>Willow Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Located nearest to the north east corner of Willow Avenue and Center Street</u>
<u>Willow Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Located nearest to the north west corner of Willow Avenue and Center Street</u>
<u>John F Kennedy Plaza</u>		<u>As designated by the Chief of Police by appropriate signage</u>
<u>North Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Two (2) spaces as designated by the Chief of Police by appropriate signage</u>

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
