WHEREAS, the Local Finance board permits an increase in the temporary appropriations as may be necessary due to the extension.

RESOLUTION OPPOSING NEW JERSEY'S BALLOT REDESIGN AND INCREASED PETITION SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, democracy thrives on fairness, transparency, and accessibility, ensuring that all candidates, regardless of party affiliation or political connections, have an equal opportunity to run for office and serve their communities; and

WHEREAS, the NJ State Legislature recently passed A5116/S4142 which was then signed into law by Governor Murphy, changes New Jersey's ballot design and the increased signature requirements for petitions; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge that this bill is large step in the right direction following U.S. District Court Judge Zahid Quraishi's 2024 judgement concerning ballot placement; and

WHEREAS, we feel that though the removal of county line bracketing is a positive move towards in the journey towards fair ballot design, we feel this bill does not go far enough to ensure the spirit of Judge Quraishi's decision; and

WHEREAS, the use of alphanumeric markers, lack of requirements on font and formatting, join petition bracketing and increased signature requirement make it harder for grassroots candidates and independent voices to compete; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Working Families Party, the American Civil Liberties Union of New Jersey, and Make the Road Action New Jersey along with U.S. Senator for NJ Andy Kim have spoken out against this bill.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Garwood, strongly opposes the recent changes to New Jersey's ballot design and petition signature requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we call upon our representatives in the Legislature to amend this bill to and increase fairness and accessibility to our electoral process.
